- (Montessori, Waldorf, Rudolf Steiner...)




Kunskapsskolan has many advantages

- Good conditions for high levels of knowledge and grades




Grade goals – the basis for a personalized education



- From your first year, you set ultimate goals
- The ultimate goals are fixed until they are changed in a development discussion
- Starting point for your and the teachers' work
- Documented in your study plan



Grade goals – the basis for your work



- The ultimate goals are broken down into semester/term goals and weekly learning and working goals.
- You plan the work of the week from your weekly working goals.
- Your personal coach helps you and monitors your work.
- Your goals are documented in your logbook.



Personal coaching

 Once a week, you and your coach discuss your progress in relation to your goals and the plan for the coming week in terms of goals and strategies and your time plan






Steps and themes

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
