

About special needs upper secondary school (Gymnasiesärskola)



The upper secondary school is a four-year education which prepares for work, continuing studies, social life and adult life.



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National program

On the national programs there are subjects that everyone should read, upper secondary school subjects. The education covers 2500 points. The guaranteed teaching time is 3600 hours divided into four years.

The programs are occupationally designed to prepare students for work within these areas. Appropriate for students who are able to work and work independently, with the help of supervisors.

As grades for approved results, E, D, C, B and A are used, where A is the highest grade. For the student who did not qualify for grade E, grades are not set.



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National program

- The administration, commerce and logistics program
- The hotel, restaurant and bakery program
- The health, healthcare and nursing program
- The property, installation and construction program



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Education at a workplace (APL)

Workplace-based learning is a big part of the students' education. This should be in line with the program's objectives and the student's education.



On the national program the student has at least 22 weeks of APL.

Integration

Integration with the three-year secondary school program. implemented to give the students opportunity to read single courses. (within their professional skills)



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Individuel program

Students who cannot pursue a course in a national program have to follow an individual program.

The individual program contain these subject areas (ämnesområden):

- art
- home and consumer studies
- sport and health
- nature and the environment
- the individual and society
- language and communication.

Instead of grades, the teacher assesses and evaluates the student's skills on the basis of requirements of basic skills and advanced skills. This enables the teacher to adapt the requirements according to each student's situation.



For students on the Individual Program During the latter year's education, students will be given the opportunity to practice according to their conditions.

The education is intended to provide students with the skills to be as independent and active as possible and to participate in community life. The content of an individual program can be designed based on each individual's needs and conditions.

Autism

Autism activity is for pupils with developmental disorder in combination with a diagnosed autism.

The method of work is individualized and has its foundation in clearing education with a low affective response in focus. The learning environment is adapted to the needs of students with clarity and structure at the center.



Combine national programs and individual programs

An individual program allows students to combine subjects from national program and subject areas. The head teacher decides what a student may combine. Such a decision shall be stated by the student individual study plan.

Certificate

Upon completion of the education, the student receives a secondary school certificate that describes the knowledge and experience acquired by the student.
