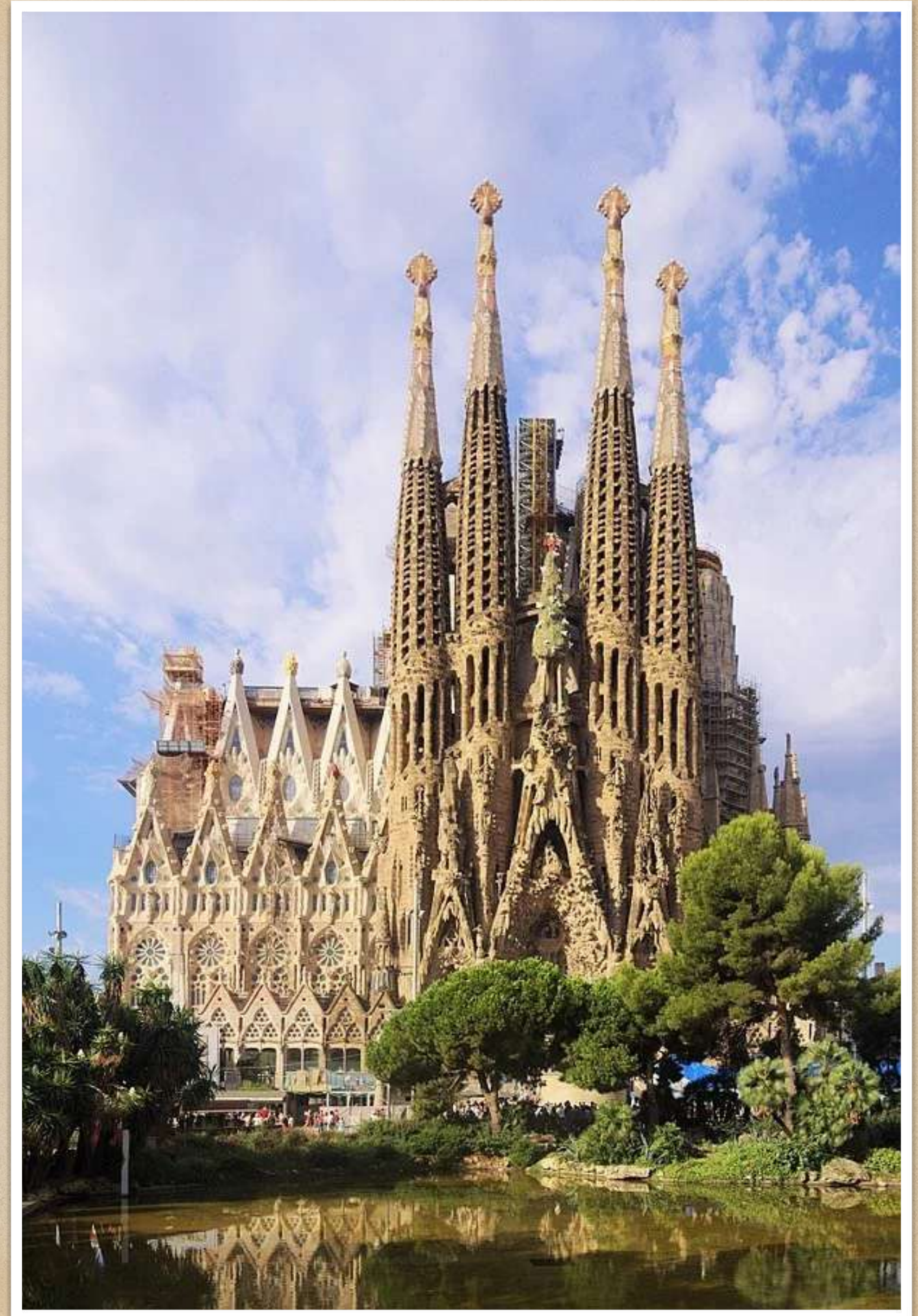

# Sagrada família

The Sagrada Família is a very important monument in Barcelona, which has parts that are made from materials left over from other structures, construction began in 1882, today it is not finished, but it is expected to be finished in 2026 to celebrate the centenary of Gaudí's death.





# Casa Batlló

Gaudí was building this amazing work of art, he was inspired in marine and in the sea.

# La pedrera

La pedrera was inaugurated in 1912 in Barcelona, it is located in Passeig de Gràcia. Some people say that it was inspired by the mountains of the Montserrat, but what can be seen is that the design was based on nature.





# Parc güell

The construction of Park Güell began in 1899, Gaudí was inspired by English gardens to create an urban garden.

The work on Park Güell was completed in 1984.





# Casa/Museu de Gaudí

The Gaudí House-Museum opened  
to the public in 1963.

Antoni Gaudí lived in the house for  
20 years. He moved in with his father  
and a niece. Today it is a museum  
open to the public.
