Extinct animals



For the past century the number of endangered/extinct animals has rapidly increased. Animals like mamouths and dodos have already been extinct a long time ago.

The most recent extinction was about the ivory-billed woodpecker in 2021.



Main reasons for animals to become extinct/endangered

- Hunting. Overhunting/overfishing or hunting endangered species lead to extinction.
- Climate change. Changing the environment where animals live.
- Nitrogen pollution. Mainly caused by cars, fertilizers and animal manure.
- Invasive animals. Animals that are aggressive might effect an others animals life.

▶ Giant panda. The giant panda lives in very few part of China and eats 99% of

the time bamboos and leafs.



▶ Tiger. The tiger lives in central and south west Asia, it can be 306 kilos.

Gorilla. Gorillas live in tropical forests of equatorial Africa and they can be

really aggressive if they sense danger.

Blue whale. Blue whales are the largest
animal to ever live with a whooping 30 meters long and
200 tonnes.



Endangered animals in Greece

▶ Brown bear. Greek brown bears live in north-western and north-eastern part of the country, in Pindos mountain range.

Caretta Caretta. The sea turtle weighs approximately 135 kg and it is about 90cm.





Endangered animals in Greece

Monachus Monachus. This seal grows from approximately 80 centimeters long at birth, up to an average of 2.4 meters and today they are less than 600 left.

Mediterranean wolf. The colour of the wolf is predominantly brown and grey.
It weighs 20-40 kilos and has a lifespan of 8-16 years.

- Visit a national wildlife refuge, park or other open space. These protected lands provide habitat to many native wildlife, birds, fish and plants.
