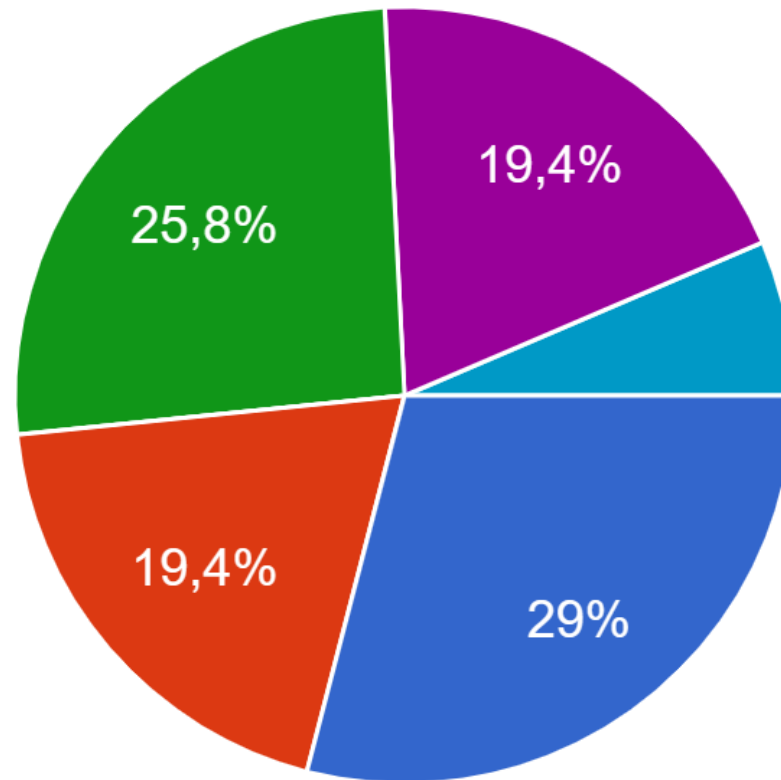

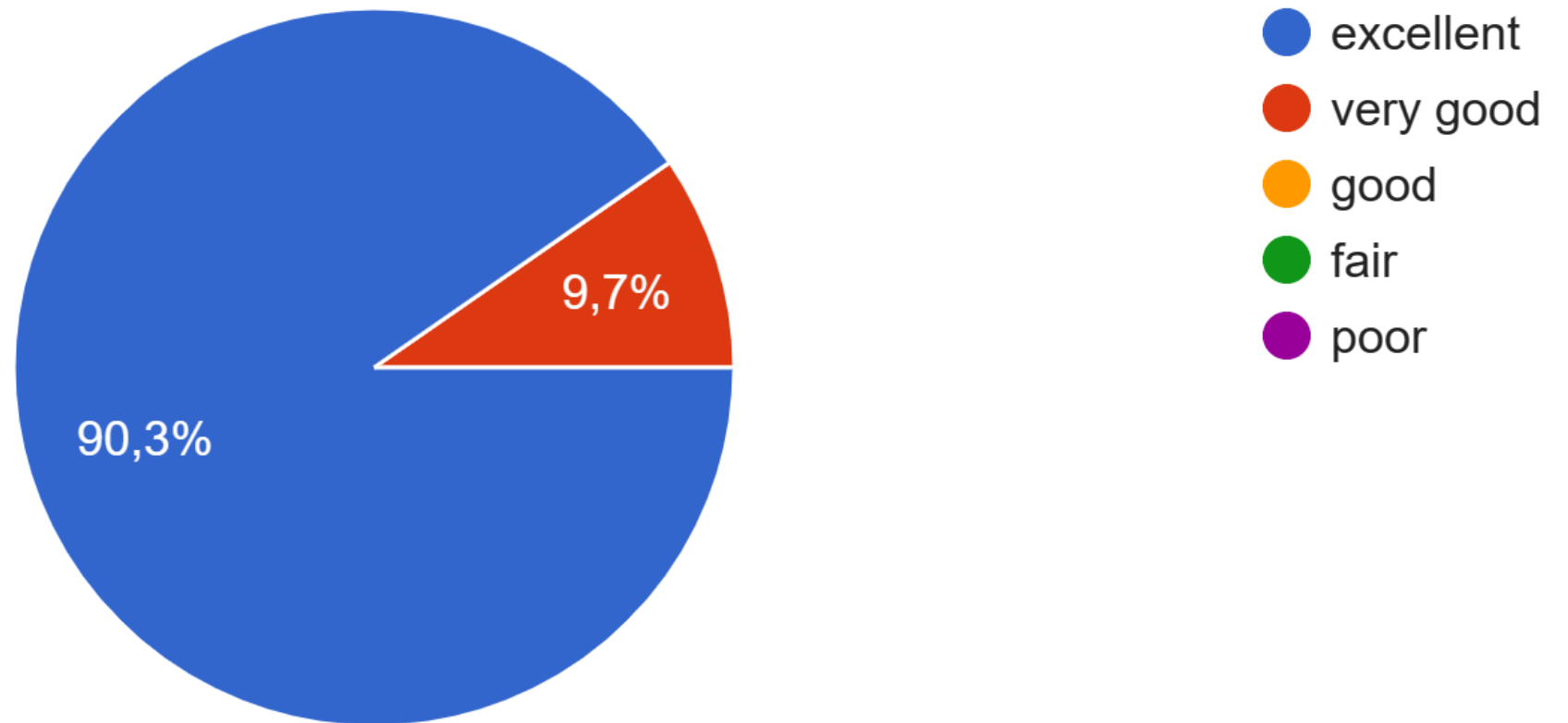

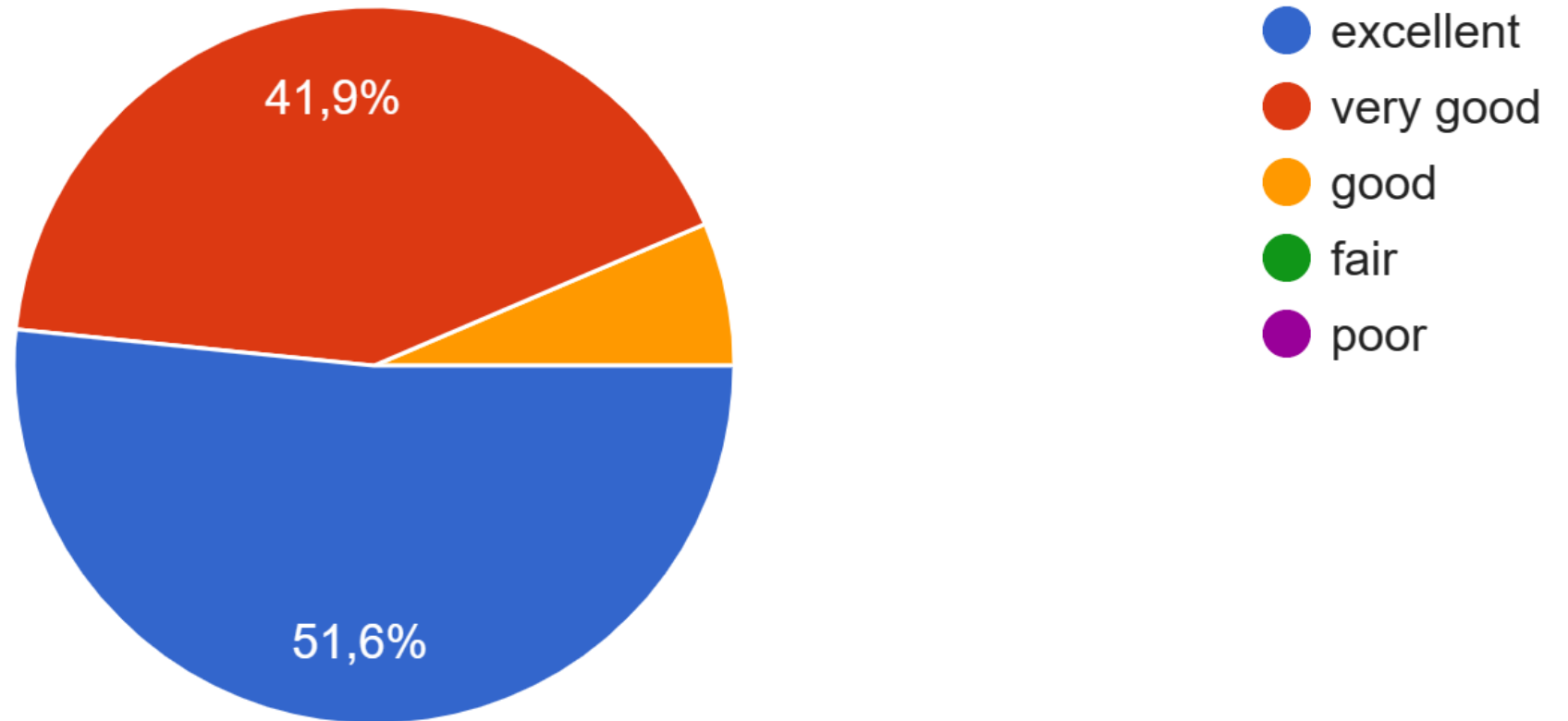
What is your overall evaluation of the experience in taking part in an Erasmus

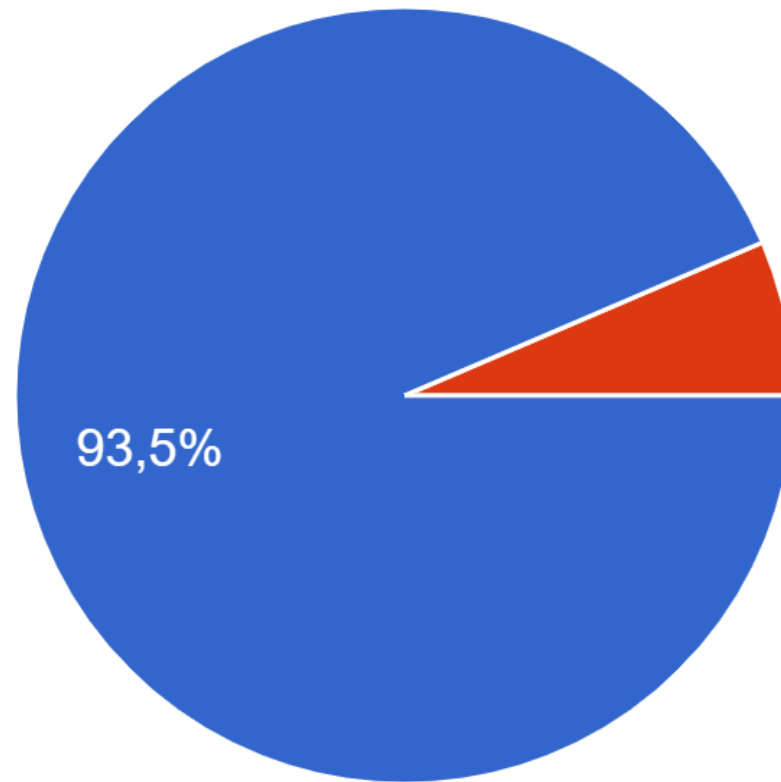
How do you assess the project related activities during the meeting?

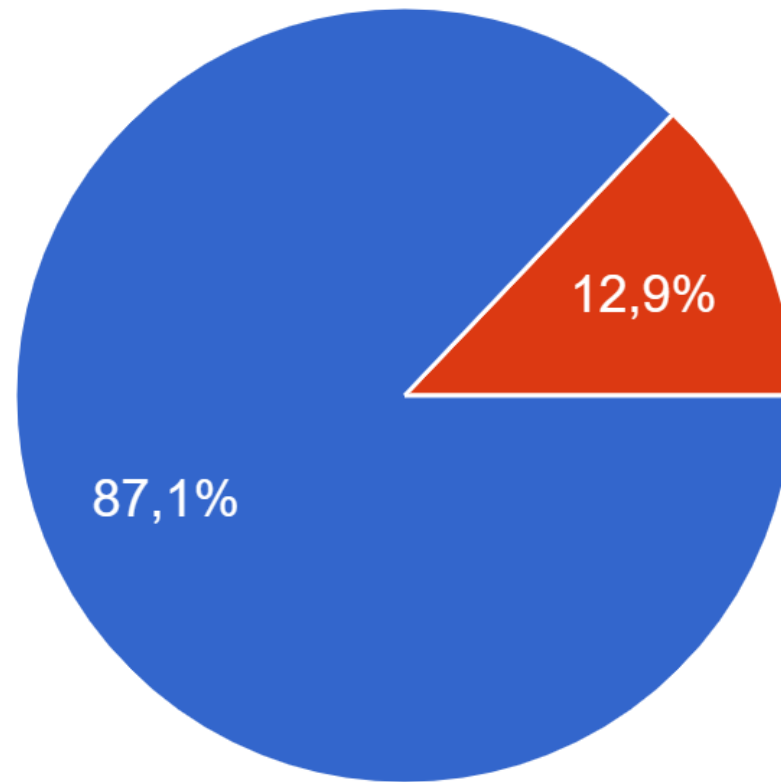

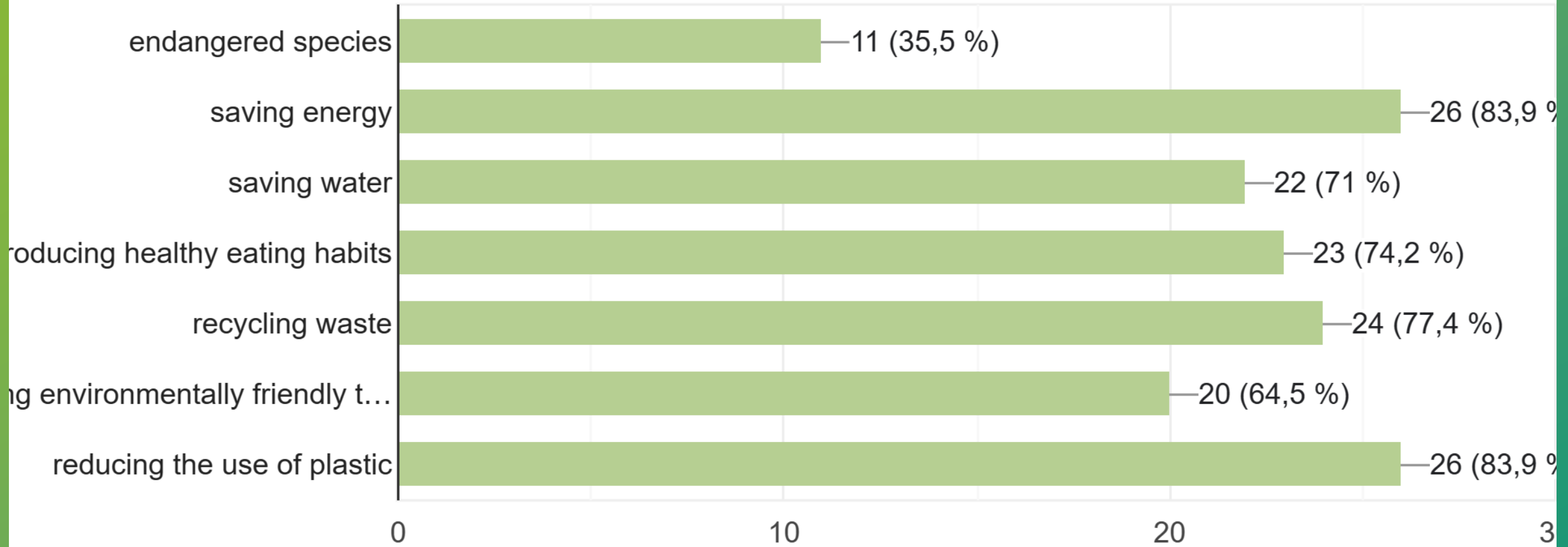

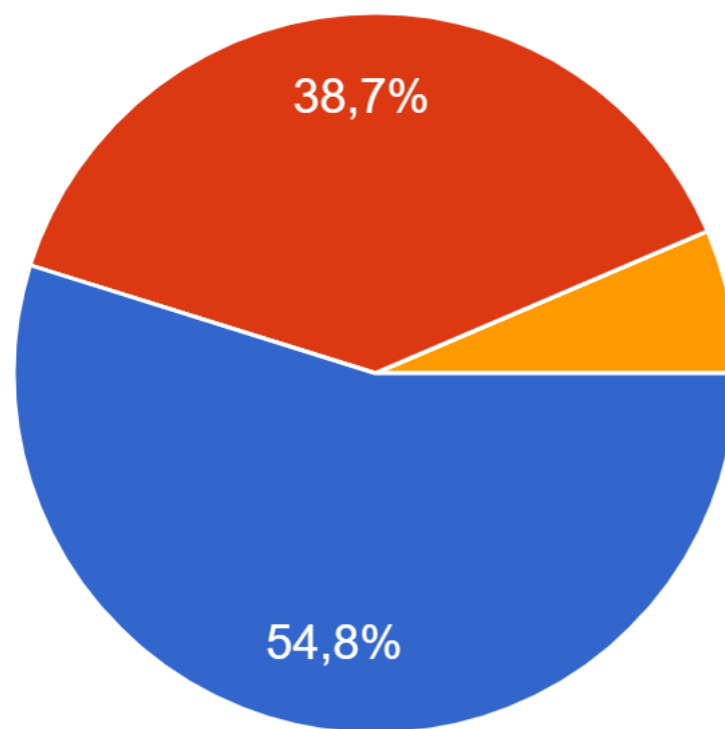

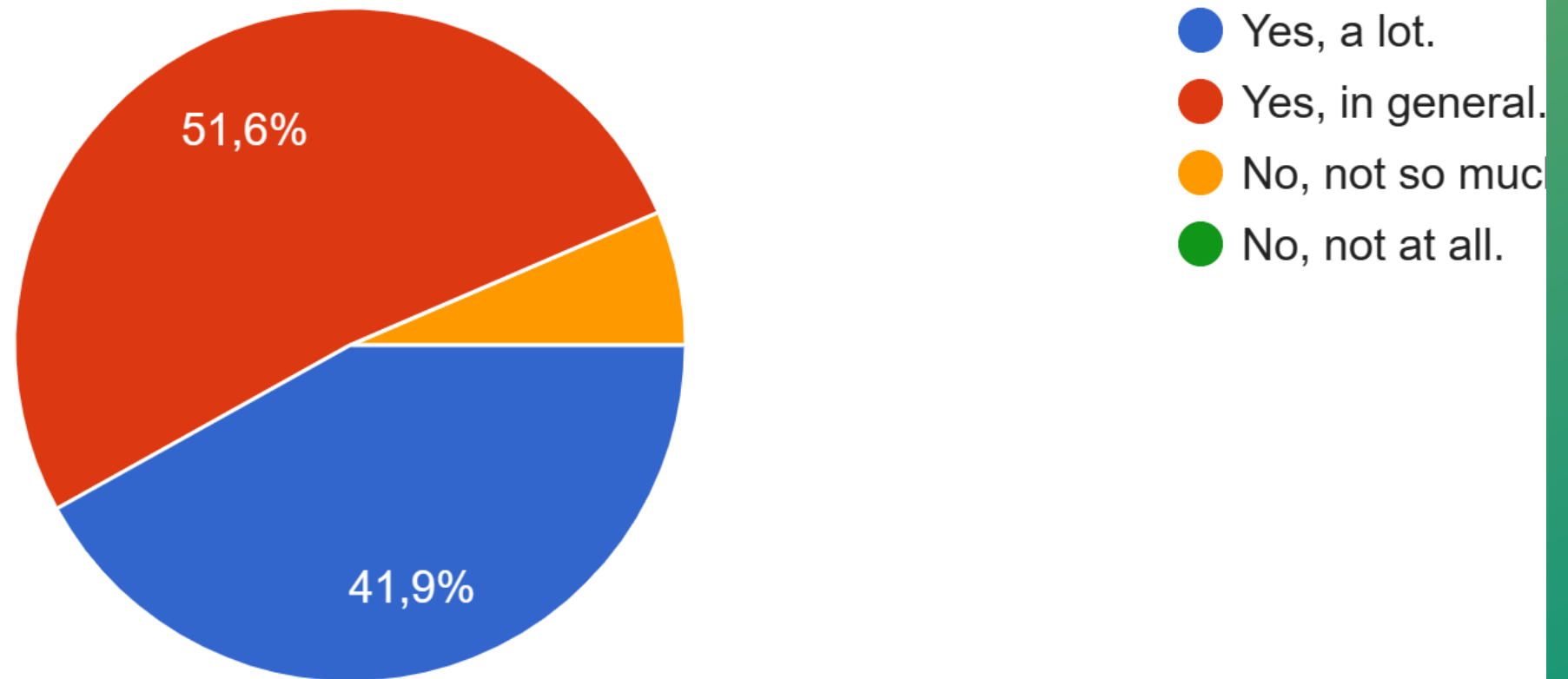
