Topic: learning environments

1 Think about

Through the next four Building Challenges you are invited to explore what you know and think about the classroom as a learning environment.

Build

Build a model that represents the classroom you often use

Building time: 5 minutes

Share

Show your building and look at the others. Ask if there is anything unclear.

Keep your model on your own building plate.

IMPORTANT RULE: never use bricks from another box then your own

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2 Remember

Now continue building on your classroom, but keep also a mind the things that didn't go well in the last year/months

Build

Build a model that represents your classroom, but also show at least one difficult experience you had. Your model must help you to share your experience with the others.

Building time: 5 minutes

Share

When the building time is up, take turns **with 1 neighbor** telling each other about what you have built.

Keep your model on your own building plate.

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3 Imagine

Now use your creativity!

Address the difficulties & try to solve them.

Build

Imagine how a future classroom setting could help with your experiences. Make a learning environment that is ready for the future!

Building time: 5 minutes

Share

When the building time is up, take turns telling the group about what you have built. Keep your model on your own building plate.

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4 Conclude

This last Building Challenge will help you to summarise your group's understanding of a learning enviroment and draw conclusions.

Build

Team up with one person. Choose one classroom, put the other one away.

Add to you model what summarizes the best ideas from the group.
