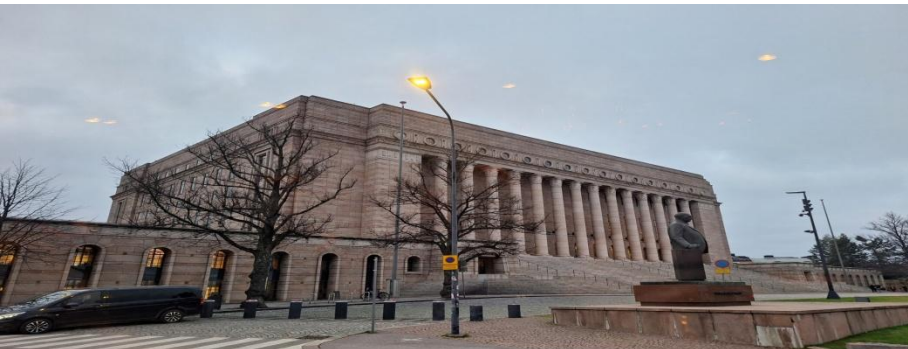


Erasmus mobility in Finland!!!

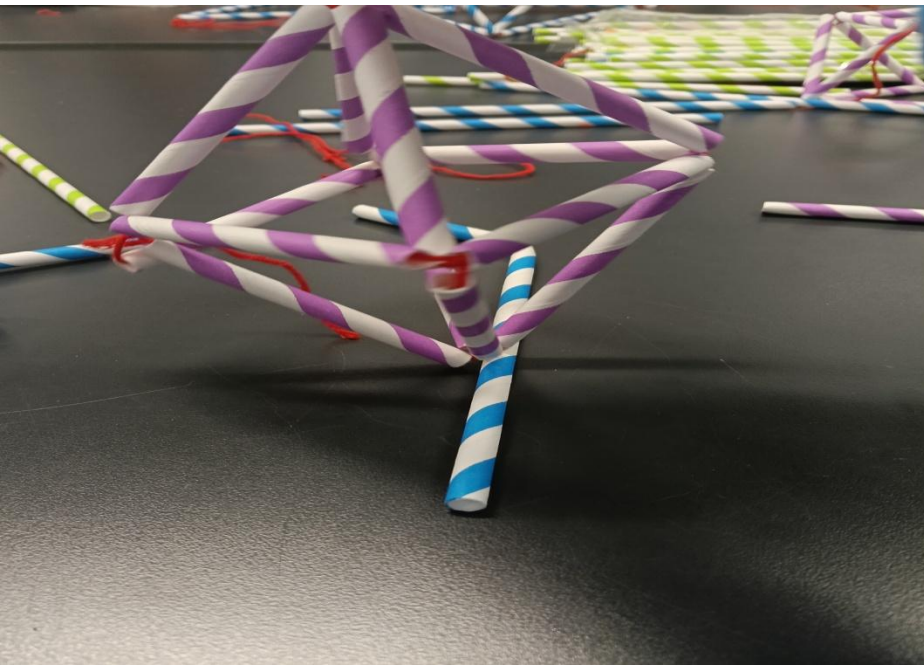
